

GOVERNMENT OF JAPAN



The Government of Japan through its International Cooperation Agency (JICA) has been providing project support and non-project grants to Sierra Leone over the years. Project support covers Agriculture, Energy and Health sectors. Non- project grants are provided in the form of commodity supplies such as rice and/or fuel.

The total support from Japan to the Government of Sierra Leone in 2020 was estimated at **\$11.29 million**. The majority of the Government of Japan's support was in Cluster II, which accounts for approximately **65 percent (\$7.31 million)** of their total support.
