NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL RESILIENCE

Ministry of Environment established in 2019 to increase political investment in the area of environmental sustainability

Key climate-sensitive sectors and community hazards identified and monitoring to increase early response capability of the state

Sea Level Rise planning and monitoring also heightened to inform early response capability

The National Disaster Management Agency established to strengthen early warning and response posture of the state

More than 54 enforcement officers trained on the risks relating to toxic chemicals, hazardous & ozone-depleting substances

FOREST MANAGEMENT AND WETLANDS CONSERVATION

More than 2,000 hectares of forest restored nationwide



More than 100 hectares of woodlots established

More than 300,000 trees planted in all agricultural districts

About 3,000 trees planted in three flood-prone communities within the Western Area
Hundreds of forest guard recruited and deployed

Tree planting created over 20,000 temporary and permanent jobs at community levels

Hundreds of forest guard recruited and deployed



More than 12 hectares of land afforested to offset degradation effect from the CLSG sub-regional energy project connecting Côte d'Ivoire, Liberia, Sierra Leone and Guinea.
